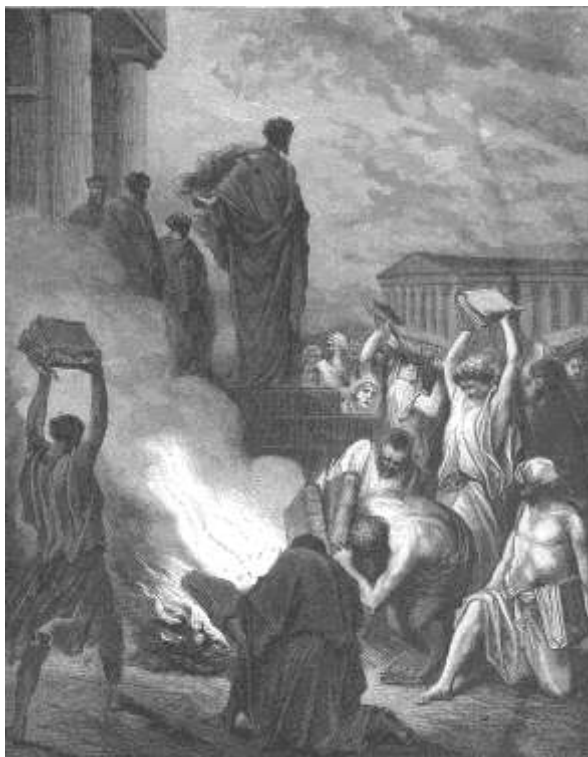

4. Have spoken with the pastor prior to the service regarding communion.

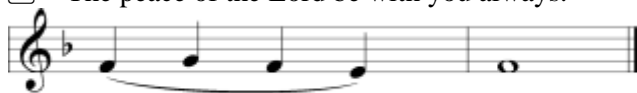

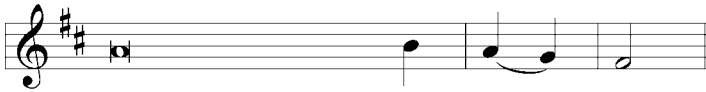

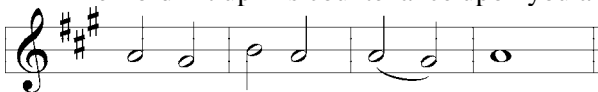
