

## Greetings in Christ!

This month, you will likely see farmers harvesting corn and soybeans. Many of the seeds that were planted last year have multiplied exponentially. One kernel of corn can grow into a plant that produces, on average, an ear of corn with 800 kernels (Source: [www.incorn.org](http://www.incorn.org)). 800% growth is incredible! God has designed plants to multiply and grow at incredible rates. He gave such fruitfulness to the earth and its plants by His powerful Word. God simply said **“Let the earth sprout vegetation, plants yielding seed, and fruit trees bearing fruit in which is their seed...”**, and the text of Genesis later says **“And it was so.”** God’s Word worked to create incredible variety and fruitfulness in one day!

The same God who makes the seed bear abundant fruit is able to work through His Word to cause each one of us to bear abundant fruit in praise and thanksgiving to Him and love toward others. Consider what God says to us in Psalm 1 (ESV), **“Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of scoffers; but his delight is in the law of the LORD, and on His law he meditates day and night. He is like a tree planted by streams of water that yields its fruit in its season, and its leaf does not wither. In all that he does, he prospers.”** The person who regularly meditates on the Word of God is fed and sustained by God’s Word. That Word yields fruit as the Holy Spirit strengthens us in faith, in our confession of Jesus, and in love for others. This fruit is more valuable than the yield from a kernel of corn or an investment in the stock market. The yield from the Word of God in one’s life is of eternal

benefit. Trust that God can cause His Word to bear abundant fruit in you. His Word is worth our study and contemplation each day.
